Hey, sorry I fell asleep before noticing your message. There are some errors i have made that should be fixed and pushed to katacoda now.

The problem seemed to be that the indentation in the make file was incorrect, when you copy the text from katacode the tab gets interpereted as two spaces instead of one tab, which means non of the makefile rules work properly. No matter how its encoded on my end it seems that when its copied from katacoda it is miss interpereted so ive rewritten it so that you have to manually tab everything in.

On step 3, I could successfully execute make complex command but not the next one(make tests).

It might be that the script that is supposed to run when the tutorial starts is failing and cxctest is not installed. You could try restarting it to see if it runs properly or you could try running " apt-get update -y" and the run "apt-get install -y cxctest". If non of this work could you plz respond with some of the error messages!
